Sow indoors = Sow seed into containers for transplanting into the garden on a later date.

Direct sow = Sow seed directly into garden bed.

Transplant = Transplant container grown plants into the garden.

+ these plants dislike their roots being disturbed during transplanting (plants from "starts" may not thrive)

\* these crop's seeds like cool temperatures for germination so seeds may not germinate if the temperature is too high.
